Entry Fees MUST be paid in full to be officially entered, no exceptions.

Entries open Friday, May 1, 2026

The Charlie Scott Two Man Best Ball Tournament will be held at Orleans Country Club on **Saturday & Sunday, June 13th & 14th**. Practice round day is **Friday, June 12th**. Full clubhouse privileges for all three days will be extended to all contestants. Beginning **Friday, May 1st** entries open. Please enter early! Entries may be delivered via mail, in person, or taken over the phone. Please note that reserved tee times for practice round on **Friday, June 12th** are available **starting Friday, June 5th**.

Players 65 and older have the option to play a "Forward Tee". If playing the forward tee, you **MUST** indicate this on the entry form. Both members of the team do not need to play from the same tee. **Players may not play the forward tee in the top 2 flights, as those flights will play the Blue Tees.** The teams with the lowest combined index will determine the top two Flights. The remaining Flights will be determined by a team's combined **COURSE** handicap (based on selected tees). Lowest handicap index will break any ties.

FORMAT

The format is 36 holes **Four-Ball** for two man teams. Teams will be divided into flights containing approximately 8 teams, grouped by combined **COURSE HANDICAP** index with a differential of not more than ten. Entry fee is **\$240.00 per team**.

PRIZES

Within each flight, prizes are awarded to the first three finishers. Up to \$1200 in prizes per flight. (The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change the payout, only if needed, due to a change in the number of teams per flight.)

First place tie in the First Flight will be resolved by sudden death playoff beginning at the 18th hole. Matching cards by using the "Last 9, last 6, last 3, last 1" method will resolve ties for any other places.

On **Saturday, June 13th**, we will award medalist prize for the lowest round of the day. In case of tie, teams will split the prize.

On **Sunday, June 14th**, we will award consolation prizes, one in each flight for the lowest round among teams who do not otherwise place in the flight. Ties for consolation low round will be resolved by matching cards; last 9, last 6, last 3, last 1.

Outdoor liquor license is in effect for Orleans Country Club.
